In recognition of superior, early achievements in research by young engineering faculty members as evidenced by demonstrated ability to conduct original research, by scholarly contributions to the literature, and by introduction of new and/or improved laboratory techniques and instrumentation. There shall also be evidence of acceptance of the results of the research through citations or applications by other workers and/or by industry. No more than one nomination from each curriculum each year.

Eligibility –

1. Any College of Engineering faculty member is eligible who has had at least three (3) years of service at Iowa State University in a tenured or tenure-track position, and will be within 10 years of having received the Ph.D. or will not have reached his or her 38th birthday by the end of the calendar year in which the award is conferred, whichever comes last.
2. A majority of the work on which the nomination is based must have been done at ISU.
3. Past recipients are not eligible.

Award: Recipient receives a \$500 honorarium and a plaque.
